

OMAHA, NE - Congressman Lee Terry (NE-02) spearheaded a Nebraska delegation letter in support of locating the Air Force Financial Transformation Customer Service Call Center at Offutt AFB in Bellevue, NE.

**"The selection of Offutt for the site will be a great opportunity for Nebraskans as well as the Air Force," said Terry. "The new mission would both benefit from and enrich the Bellevue/Offutt community. We are pleased for the Air Force's consideration. I will continue to encourage Offutt expansion as a way to improve job growth in Sarpy County ."**

The letter is addressed to the Honorable Pete Geren, Secretary of the Air Force at the Pentagon. Signed by all three representatives and both Senators, the letter highlights the strengths of Offutt AFB and the Bellevue community to host the new mission: "infrastructure, quality of life, housing and education."

A Department of Defense (DOD) selection team recently visited Offutt AFB to determine the feasibility for locating the Financial Services Transformation Customer Service Call Center on the base. The Call Center could bring an estimated 775 jobs to Offutt AFB, 80% of which are military.
