Card Guidelines:

Every card will be screened for hazardous materials and reviewed.

All cards should be postmarked no later than Friday, December 9, 2011.

All cards must be signed.

Use generic salutations such as "Dear Service Member" or "To a Great American."

Only cards will be accepted. Do not send letters.

Do not include personal contact information (addresses, e-mail).

Do not include inserts of any kind – including photos.

Participants should limit the number of cards they submit to 25 per individual or 50 from any class or group. Each card does not need its own envelope.
