

OMAHA - On Tuesday, July 3, Congressman Lee Terry will be at Bucky's Express, an alternative fuels refueling station near 108th and L streets to discuss alternative fuels and customer demand for E-85, and to meet with station manager Al Milledge and supervisor Jim Pitzmeier. Congressman Terry will visit with the public about their views on E-85, discuss his views and initiatives on energy security, and meet members of the press to highlight energy independence and E-85, one important energy source to diversify America's energy portfolio and reduce dependence on foreign oil.

Bucky's is Omaha's second station to offer the E-85 fuel used by flex-fuel vehicles. The first station to offer alternative fuels was Cubby's on 13th Street in downtown Omaha. □

Congressman Terry introduced the E-85 Promotion Act (H.R. 2858) this week to spur the use and production of E-85 fuel.
