

OMAHA - Congressman Terry announced today that Charles Drew Health Center and OneWorld Community Health Centers each have been awarded a Federal grant to support critical health services for the homeless and uninsured.

"I strongly support Omaha 's community health centers, and I am pleased that these substantial grants will support the critical health care services they provide with skill and care for many members of our community who might otherwise not receive it," Terry said.

Charles Drew will receive an annual award of \$586,616 to expand its health care for the homeless operations. OneWorld Community Health Centers will receive an annual award of \$600,000 to expand services to children, adolescents, women, young mothers, and the elderly.

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has notified Congressman Terry that the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) grant for Charles Drew Health Center will be formally awarded by Elizabeth Duke, Ph.D., HRSA Administrator, at a press conference:
