

OMAHA - Congressman Terry has introduced legislation to secure a national veterans cemetery to serve veterans and their families in Eastern Nebraska and Western Iowa. Congressmen Jeff Fortenberry and Adrian Smith are original cosponsors of the measure. Iowa Congressman Steve King is also cosponsoring.

Congressman Terry invites veterans and their families to join him and veterans leaders who will speak in support of H.R. 2551, directing the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a national cemetery in Sarpy County, Nebraska. Terry will hold a press conference after the morning ceremony at Memorial Park tomorrow. The Vietnam Veterans of America ceremony concludes at 12 p.m. Congressman Terry and veterans leaders will make remarks in the rose garden to the north of the colonnade at 12:30 p.m.:
