

WASHINGTON- Congressman Lee Terry, who sits on the powerful Energy and Commerce Committee participated in a hearing today to learn more about Toyota's recall of millions cars. The Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations held a hearing to look into consumer complaints about the safety of Toyota vehicles.

"Congress has an obligation to look into allegations that Toyota may have covered up safety issues with their vehicles," said Congressman Terry. "My number one priority is making sure Toyota is doing everything it can to keep consumers safe. I also want to know that the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the agency responsible for oversight of carmakers on safety design, has been doing its job. I found the testimony today quite disturbing and it is imperative that serious safety changes be made in the Toyota company."
