

WASHINGTON- Congressman Terry issued the following statement after learning Offutt AFB was not chosen to be the headquarters for the new Air Force Global Strike Command.

"I am disappointed that Offutt was not chosen as the headquarters of the Air Force's new Global Strike Command. I have long believed that the bases infrastructure and presence of STRATCOM coupled with our community's highly skilled and capable workforce made Offutt stand out as the obvious and best choice for the Command. I will continue to be an advocate for Offutt as the Air Force finalizes its decision on the new Numbered Air Force that will be responsible for the Cyber Warfare Mission and do all I can to secure that mission for Offutt as its new home for that mission."

Global Strike Command will take over all of the Air Force's missions inside the United States.
