

WASHINGTON- Congressman Lee Terry (R-NE) issued the following statement after Iran conducted a second day of missile tests.

"These missile tests are unfortunate because they further destabilize security in the Middle East and pose a direct threat to our troops in Iraq and our friend Israel. I would encourage President Bush to continue the diplomatic process with Iran and involve Russia in that process. I support current and future sanctions on Iran and encourage the UN to be more aggressive in enforcing them, as they have put both political and economic pressure on the Iran government. If it were not for Iran's oil, they would not have money for missile testing. This underscores that our nation's biggest national security threat is our dependence on foreign oil," said Congressman Lee Terry.
