

WASHINGTON- Congressman Terry (R-NE) wants to remind all Nebraskans that the Internal Revenue Service has begun distributing tax rebate checks. Checks will be deposited electronically into taxpayers' accounts starting this week. Paper checks will be mailed to taxpayers who do not use direct deposit beginning in mid-May. These payments were a part of the economic stimulus package passed by Congress in February.
