

OMAHA, Neb. -- U.S. Rep. Lee Terry said the metro area is the ideal location for a national veterans cemetery, which was authorized by President Barack Obama's 2011 budget.

Terry said many veterans live close to Omaha, and they deserve to be buried in a veterans cemetery close to home.
