

A new dual franchise auto dealership opened in Omaha on Monday, the same day General Motors filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy.

The Mitsubishi dealership at 182nd and West Dodge Road will be a dual franchise with Infiniti of Omaha. Owner Sammy Reagan has spent the last two months securing the franchise after the closing of Metro Mitsubishi at the end of March. Eight new jobs were created.
