

WASHINGTON -- Rep. Lee Terry, R-Neb., has been named one of the easiest Republicans to work with in a survey of House Democrats conducted by the Hill, a Washington-based news paper.

The paper reported that it asked more than 100 House members to name those in the opposite party who were the most partisan and those who were the most bipartisan.

Terry made the top 10 list of bipartisan House members and was the only one from the Midlands on either list. The choice of Terry, a pretty reliable GOP vote, may seem puzzling.

Terry said bipartisanship is not just about how a lawmaker votes, but how he treats people.

"Plus, they like my sense of humor," Terry joked.
