

WASHINGTON (AP) -- Nebraska Congressman Lee Terry has found a point of agreement with President Barack Obama.

Terry, a Republican who represents Nebraska's 2nd District, agrees with Obama's decision to send more troops to Afghanistan. Terry says it's a necessary step in the war on terror.

Obama has announced plans to boost the U.S. military presence in Afghanistan by 50 percent, which would send an additional 17,000 troops to a 30,000 force contingent already there.
