

**Congressman's Mother, Former News
Anchor's Wife, Dies**
Jan Terry Was 74

OMAHA, Neb. -- Jan Terry, a longtime Nebraska Republican, the mother of a Nebraska congressman, and a member our KETV family, has passed away.

Terry died Saturday morning at the age of 74.

She was the wife of Kaleidoscope analyst and former KETV anchor Lee Terry Sr. and mother of Rep. Lee Terry Jr. In a statement, Lee Terry Sr. said, "Jan took pride in her son and always worked hard for him. Jan always said for half of her life she was known as Lee Terry's wife and for the other half she was know as Lee Terry Jr.'s mom. She always took pride in both. She was also our biggest critic."

Rep. Lee Terry Jr. told us his mother was the "go-to" person for so many Republican campaigns. He also said she was a delegate for Ronald Reagan at Republican national conventions in 1980 and 1984.

He also told us his mother always called herself an Iowa farm girl and she loved being "Grandma Jan."
