

Rep. Terry Introduces Bill to Clarify Authority of NRC Chairman Regarding Emergencies

WASHINGTON, Dec. 14 -- Rep. Lee Terry, R-Neb., has introduced legislation (H.R. 3657) to "clarify the authority of the Chairman of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to act on behalf of the Commission during emergencies."

The bill was introduced on Dec. 13 and was co-sponsored by Reps. Joe L. Barton, R-Texas, and Michael C. Burgess, R-Texas.

The legislation was referred to the House Energy and Commerce Committee.
