

GOP calls 'bull' on Obama's Keystone delay

House Republicans returned to work Tuesday evening with a sharp message for President Obama that there is no reason for delaying the Keystone XL pipeline, with one member arguing that the Obama administration's reasons for delay so far are "bull."

Rep. Lee Terry (R-Neb.) said on the House floor Tuesday night that the administration last year said repeatedly that it had all the information it needed to decide on the oil pipeline, and that it was "working diligently" toward a decision by the end of 2011. But Terry said officials then argued that they needed more information, and were worried that Republicans were forcing a decision that might have to go against the pipeline.
