

Committee Leaders to White House:

Time to Quit Stonewalling on Solyndra

WH Continues Withholding Documents and Shielding Key Staff from Investigators - Committee Will Pursue Subpoenas Unless Key Players Are Made Available by February 17th, Sets February 21st Deadline for All Docs

WASHINGTON, DC – House Energy and Commerce Committee Chairman Fred Upton joined every member of the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations in urging full White House compliance related to the Committee's subpoenas on Solyndra. Despite repeated attempts by the Committee to accommodate the White House, the White House has turned over only 515 pages of internal West Wing Solyndra communications since the subpoenas were issued nearly 100 days ago on November 3, 2011. The Committee also highlighted the White House's extensive delays in a memorandum attached to the letter.
