

Rep. Walden appoints cybersecurity working group

Rep. Greg Walden (R-Ore.), chairman of the Energy and Commerce subcommittee on Communications and Technology, appointed three Democrats and three Republicans to a working group to study cybersecurity issues on Wednesday.

The lawmakers are Reps. Lee Terry (R-Neb.), Anna Eshoo (D-Calif.), Doris Matsui (D-Calif.), Bob Latta (R-Ohio), Mike Doyle (D-Pa.) and Adam Kinzinger (R-Ill.).

The group will study "legal impediments" to securing private computer networks against cyberattacks. The group will report its findings back to Walden.
