

**Congressman says Obama 'simply bizarre'**

Nebraska Rep. Terry criticizes decision to torpedo pipeline plan

Rep. Lee Terry, R-Neb., is continuing to push for the Obama administration to approve the Keystone XL pipeline, which is expected to create large numbers of jobs for an industry that could employ thousands in the U.S.

In an interview with Greg Corombos of Radio America for WND, Terry called Obama's rejection of the plan "simply bizarre."

The plan was at least temporarily rejected by Obama, who said congressional Republicans imposed a timetable that did not allow him to evaluate the impact of the pipeline.
