More than 20 local officials and businessmen gathered at the Sarpy County Chamber of Commerce office June 11 to discuss security in the digital age.

Rep. Lee Terry headlined the event, along with four other experts who weighed in and shared advice on cyber threats to power companies, small businesses and telecommunications from threats both foreign and domestic.

Terry, one of 12 members on the Cyber-Security Task Force formed by House Speaker John Boehner, said the government is trying to legislate more impactful private sector measures against cyber threats.
